**In Ontario, there are three
General Farm Organizations
(GFOs) including the NFU.**

**Every year you can decide to
join one of them. Who you
belonged to in the past does
not matter. If you join the
NFU, your FBR number
(which gives you your PST
exemption and property tax
rebate) simply comes with
you and will be on your new
NFU card.**

The number is assigned to you by
Agricorp. The number belongs to *you* ,
regardless of which GFO you choose
to register with.

The NFU promotes the family farm as
the most appropriate and efficient
means of agricultural production.

Other jurisdictions have shown that
support for the family farm is the most
viable option for long term protection of
our land, air and water. Our goal as
